Schreyer Professor of Global Management, Policies and Planning and founding director of the Center for Global Business Studies at the Smeal College of Business at the Pennsylvania State University. He is also a Senior Advisor and Distinguished Scholar at The Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington, DC. As a consultant, academic, and author, he has established himself as a leading authority on future global business trends, global economic assessment, the petroleum industry, immigration, international finance and banking, and global corporate strategy and implementation. Most recently, Dr. Ghadar published his comprehensive study on immigration called *Becoming American: Why Immigration is Good for Our Nation's Future*.
